This petition is coming on this day for hearing before this Court in the presence of Tr.K.Marks, the Learned counsel for the petitioner and Learned APP Grade-II appearing for the State and having perusal of records, heard both parties and having stood over the same for consideration, on this day the Court delivers the following,

ORDER

1. This petition has been filed by the petitioner u/s. 480(1)(b) of BNSS Act, seeking relaxation of the condition imposed by this court in Crl.M.P.No.1513/2026 dated 29.07.2026.

2. The learned counsel of the petitioner submitted that the petitioner has been released on bail as per order of this court in Crl.M.P.No.1513/2026 dated 29.07.2026 with a condition that he shall appear and sign before the respondent / police daily at

10.00 A.M and 5.00 P.M., until further orders. It is further submitted that the petitioner has followed the condition from 05.08.2026 to till date and due signing the petitioner is not doing his work regularly and it is just and necessary to totally relax the condition imposed by this court. Accordingly, he prayed to relax the condition totally.

3. Per contra, the prosecuting agency vehemently opposed to relax the condition that if the condition is totally relaxed, the petitioner is likely to commit similar offence or there is a chance for absconding. Hence, she prayed to dismiss the application.

4. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner/accused and perused materials available on record. On perusal of records, the petitioner has been alleged offences u/s.318(4) of BNS Act and 66D of IT act in connection with Cr.No.59/2026 on the file of The Inspector of Police, Cyber Crime Police Station, Krishnagiri. The petitioner was arrested by the respondent / police and remanded to judicial custody on 29.06.2026 and he was released on bail by this court in CrI.M.P.No.1513/2026 dated 29.07.2026 subject to some conditions.

5. It could be seen from reply submitted by the respondent / police that the petitioner/accused has regularly complied the condition imposed by this court and has appeared before the respondent / police and signed from 05.08.2026 to till date. Hence, makes it clear that the petitioner is not deviated with the condition imposed by this court and has regularly complied the conditions. Considering the above facts and circumstances and submissions put forth on either side, this court is not inclined

to totally relax the condition and is inclined to modify the condition, to that effect **the petitioner/accused shall report before the respondent / police at 10.00 A.M., until further orders.**
