Petition u/s.483 BNSS is filed to relax the condition imposed on the petitioner.

This Petition has come up for final hearing before this court today, in the presence of Thiru. R. Raja Sudalai, Advocate for the petitioner and in the presence of the learned Public Prosecutor for prosecution.

Heard both side. Upon perusal of available records before this court and on consideration of oral representations made by both side, this court delivered the following:

**ORDER**

The petitioner was granted Anticipatory bail by this Court as per the order in Cr.M.P. No.653/2026 dated 05.02.2026 with one of the conditions that, the petitioner shall and appear and sign before the respondent police station daily at 10.00 a.m. until further orders.

The learned Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has been observing the condition from 23.02.2026 and thereafter, since the petitioner's father passed away on 05.03.2026, due to unfortunate incident, the petitioner was unable to affix his signature from 05.03.2026 to till date and moreover

this petitioner is studying in Government Law College, Madurai and being a final year student, it is very hard to observe the condition and that therefore, the said condition imposed upon the petitioner may be relaxed totally.

The learned Public Prosecutor has not raised any objection to relax the said condition imposed upon the petitioner and stated that the petitioner has been complying the condition from 23.02.2026 to till date.

Considering the above facts and circumstances of the case that, the petitioner has observed the said condition from 23.02.2026 and the difficulties faced by the petitioner in observing the condition, this Court is inclined to relax the said condition imposed upon the petitioner.

In the result, this petition is allowed and the said condition imposed upon petitioner in Cr.M.P. No.653/2026 dated 05.02.2026 with one of the conditions that, the petitioner shall appear and sign before the Thallakulam police station daily at 10.00 a.m. until further orders is totally relaxed.
