This is an application u/s 483 BNSS for grant of regular bail moved on behalf of accused Om Joshi.

Arguments heard. Record perused.

As per record, the applicant had remained on bail throughout the trial, however, he did not appear before the court on the previous dates and as such, warrants were issued against him. In execution of the same, he was arrested and thereafter, sent to JC.

Ld. Counsel has submitted that accused was unwell and therefore, could not appear before the court. He has further submitted that he does not have any lawyer and hence, the court could not be informed about the reason for his absence. It is further submitted that the accused undertakes to appear before the court on each and every date.

Having regards to the facts and circumstances of the case, **the applicant / accused Om Joshi is admitted to bail on his furnishing a personal bond in the sum of Rs. 25,000/- with one surety in the like amount.**

Application stand disposed of accordingly as allowed.
