Petition u/s.482 BNSS is filed to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

This Petition has come up for final hearing before this court today, in the presence of Thiru. M.Murugan, Advocate for the petitioner and the learned Public Prosecutor for prosecution.

Heard both side.

ORDER

The petitioner is alleged to have committed offences on 16.04.2026 u/s.296(b), 118(1), 351(3) of BNS and u/s.3(1) of TNPPDL Act.

The case of the prosecution is that, the petitioner abused the de-facto complainant with filthy languages, attacked him causing injuries, criminally intimidated the de-facto complainant and also damaged the two wheeler.



The learned Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is an innocent and not at all committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution and false case has been foisted against this petitioner and that the petitioners are ready and willing to furnish sufficient sureties for his release on anticipatory bail and that therefore, the petitioner may be enlarged on anticipatory bail.

The learned Public Prosecutor has raised strong objection to release the petitioner on anticipatory bail by stating that, totally six accused in this case and this petitioner is the 1st accused and that, the complainant is working in an agency and the complainant's friend is said to have got money from the accused persons and he did not return back the money, due to that, on 16.04.2026 when the complainant was coming in two wheeler, accused persons restrained him, quarreled with him, spoke abusive words, attacked with wooden logs, damaged the two wheeler, threatened and went away and further stated that, the injured was discharged from the hospital and the damage value is Rs.10,000/- and no previous case against this petitioner.

Considering the above facts and circumstances of the case that, the injured was discharged from the hospital and no previous case against this petitioner, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner subject to the following conditions:

i) In the event of arrest or on surrender, the petitioner is ordered to be released on anticipatory bail on executing a bond for Rs.10,000/- with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate No.I, Thoothukudi,

ii) The petitioner shall deposit cash security of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five thousand only) before the Judicial Magistrate Court No.I, Thoothukudi and the de-facto complainant is permitted to withdraw the amount on filing necessary memo before the concerned court.



iii) The petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated u/s.482 (2) (i), (ii) and (iii) of BNSS,

iv) The petitioner shall appear and sign before the respondent police station daily at 10.00 A.M from the date of release until further Orders,

v) The petitioner shall surrender before Judicial Magistrate within 15 days from the date of this order, failing which, the anticipatory bail granted to the petitioner shall stand dismissed automatically,

vi) If the petitioner breaches any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Judicial Magistrate is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed by the said officer as laid down by **the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji .vs. State of Kerala (2005 AIR SCW 5560)**,

vii) And if the petitioner, thereafter abscond, a fresh F.I.R may be registered against the petitioner u/s.269 of BNS.
