Petition u/s.482 BNSS is filed to grant anticipatory bail to petitioners.

This Petition has come up for final hearing before this court today, in the presence of Thiru.J.Ragland Ananth Advocate for petitioners and the Inspector of Police, DCB for respondent.

Heard both side.

ORDER

Petitioners are alleged to have committed offences on 09.04.2025 u/s.406, 420, 294(b), 506(1) of IPC.



The case of the prosecution is that the petitioners with other accused received Rs.5,90,000/- from the defacto complainant for getting Government job, but the accused neither got defacto complainant a Government job nor returned back the money and abused the defacto complainant with filthy language and also made criminal intimidation against the defacto complainant.

The learned Counsel for the petitioners has submitted that petitioners are innocent and not at all committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution and totally six accused in this case and these petitioners are A5 and A6 and the 1st accused is the mother of A5 and A6 and as per the version of F.I.R., A1 along with other accused have demanded money and the specific overtact against this petitioner is only 294(b) and 506(2) of IPC and that petitioners are ready and willing to furnish sufficient sureties for their release on anticipatory bail and that therefore, petitioners may be enlarged on anticipatory bail.

The Inspector of Police, DCB appeared before this court and stated that totally seven accused in this case and all the accused persons are family members and the 1st accused was released due to his health issues.

Considering the above facts and circumstances of the case and since there is no specific overtact against these petitioners, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners subject to the following conditions:

i) In the event of arrest or on surrender, petitioners are ordered to be released on anticipatory bail on executing a bond for Rs.10,000/- each with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate No.IV, Thoothukudi,

ii) Petitioners shall deposit cash security of Rs.1,00,000/- (Rupees One Lakh only) each (totally Rs.2,00,000/-) before the Judicial Magistrate Court No.IV,



Thoothukudi (the amount, if deposited, shall be kept by the above Judicial Magistrate Court in Criminal Court Deposit a/c. till the disposal of the case),

iii) Petitioners shall abide by the conditions stipulated u/s.482 (2) (i), (ii) and (iii) of BNSS,

iv) Petitioners shall appear and sign before the respondent police station daily at 10.00 A.M from the date of release until further Orders,

v) Petitioners shall surrender before the Judicial Magistrate within 15 days from the date of this order, failing which, the anticipatory bail granted to the petitioners shall stand dismissed automatically,

vi) If the petitioners breaches any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Judicial Magistrate is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioners in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed by the said officer as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji .vs. State of Kerala (2005 AIRSCW 5560),

vii) And if the petitioners, thereafter abscond, a fresh F.I.R may be registered against the petitioners u/s.269 of BNS.
