Petition u/s.483 BNSS is filed to grant bail to the petitioner.

This Petition has come up for final hearing before this court today, in the presence of Thiru.N.K.Saravanan, Advocate for the petitioner and the Inspector of Police, Sipcot P.S. for respondent.

Heard both side.

ORDER

The petitioner is alleged to have committed offences on 16.06.2026 u/s.132, 296(b), 351(3) of BNS and Section 25(1A) of Arms Act. The petitioner was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 16.06.2026.

The case of the prosecution is that, the petitioner along with the co-accused have abused the de-facto complainant who is a public servant with filthy language, deterred him from discharging his duty and also criminally intimidated with weapon.



The learned Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that, the petitioner is an innocent and not at all committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution and that the petitioner is in judicial custody from 16.06.2026 for the past 18 days and totally two accused in this case and this petitioner is the 2nd accused and due to statistical purpose false case has been registered and that the petitioner is ready and willing to furnish sufficient sureties for his release on bail and that therefore, the petitioner may be enlarged on bail.

The Inspector of Police, Sipcot Police station has appeared before this court and stated that this petitioner is having 10 previous cases.

Considering the nature and gravity of the offence and the criminal antecedents of the petitioner and the fact that, since the occurrence happened only on 16.06.2026, major part of investigation would not have been completed and if the petitioner is enlarged on bail, there is every possibility of tampering the witnesses and hampering the investigation, this court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

In the result, this petition is hereby dismissed.
