Petition u/s.483 BNSS is filed to grant bail to the petitioner.

This Petition has come up for final hearing before this court today, in the presence of Thiru.M.Raj, Advocate for the petitioner and the Inspector of Police, Maniyachi P.S. for respondent.

Heard both side.

ORDER

Petitioners are alleged to have committed offences on 13.04.2026 u/s.103(1) @ 191(1), 191(2), 3(5), 296(b), 103(1) of BNS. Petitioners were arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 15.04.2026.



The case of the prosecution is that, petitioners along with the co-accused assembled unlawfully with weapon, abused the deceased with filthy languages and murdered the deceased.

The learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that, petitioners are innocent and not at all committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution and that petitioners are in judicial custody from 15.04.2026 for the past 80 days and this is the 2nd bail application and the earlier application was dismissed by the trial court in Cr.M.P. No.2832/2026 dated 17.06.2026 and the that the co-accused was already enlarged on bail by this court and that petitioners are ready and willing to furnish sufficient sureties for their release on bail and that therefore, petitioners may be enlarged on bail.

The Inspector of Police, Maniyachi Police station has appeared before this court and stated that the case has been charge sheeted in P.R.C. No.40/2026.

Petitioners are in judicial custody for the past 80 days and there is no serious objection on the respondent side and the case has been charge sheeted in P.R.C. No.40/2026. Hence, considering the above facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioners subject to the following conditions:

i) Petitioners are ordered to be released on bail on executing a bond for Rs.10,000/- each with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate, Ottapidaram



ii) Petitioners shall appear and sign before the Judicial Magistrate Court, Ottapidaram on all working days at 10.30 A.M from the date of release for a period of 30 days,

iii) If the petitioner breaches any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Judicial Magistrate is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed by the said officer as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji .vs. State of Kerala (2005 AIRSCW 5560),

iv) And if the petitioner, thereafter abscond, a fresh F.I.R may be registered against the petitioner u/s.269 of BNS.
