Petition u/s.483 BNSS is filed to grant bail to the petitioner.

This Petition has come up for final hearing before this court today, in the presence of Thiru.M.Rajeshkumar, Advocate for the petitioner and the Inspector of Police, Pasuvanthanai P.S. for respondent.

Heard both side.

ORDER

The petitioner is alleged to have committed offences on 24.02.2022 u/s.406, 420, 468 of IPC @ 420, 465, 467, 471, 204 of IPC r/w Section 34 of IPC. The petitioner was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 08.04.2026.



The case of the prosecution is that, the petitioner along with the co-accused fabricated the insurance policy, used the forged policy as a genuine document, destructed the documents and thereby cheated the de-facto complainant.

The learned Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that, the petitioner is an innocent and not at all committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution and the petitioner is in judicial custody from 08.04.2026 for the past 87 days and the earlier bail application was dismissed by the trial court in Cr.M.P. No.229/2026 dated 19.06.2026 and that the petitioner is ready and willing to furnish sufficient sureties for his release on bail and that therefore, the petitioner may be enlarged on bail.

The Inspector of Police, Pasuvanthanai police station has appeared before this court and sated that the investigation is still pending and this petitioner is having two previous cases.

Considering the nature and gravity of the offence and the criminal antecedents of the petitioner and the fact that, since the investigation is still pending, if the petitioner is enlarged on bail, there is every possibility of tampering the witnesses and hampering the investigation, this court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

In the result, this petition is hereby dismissed.
