Petition u/s.482 BNSS is filed to grant anticipatory bail to petitioners.

This Petition has come up for final hearing before this court today, in the presence of Thiru.P.Thangaraj Gandhi, Advocate for petitioners and the Inspector of Police, Kulasekarapattinam P.S. for respondent.

Heard both side.

ORDER

Petitioners are alleged to have committed offences on 22.06.2026 u/s. 296(b), 132, 351(3) of BNS and 12 TNG Act.

The case of the prosecution is that the petitioners along with other accused abused the de-facto complainant who is a public servant with filthy language, criminally intimidated him and also engaged in illegal game in the public place.

The learned Counsel for the petitioners has submitted that, petitioners are innocents and not at all committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution and that totally eight accused in this case and these petitioners are A5 to A8 and that the co-accused was released by the trial court in Cr.M.P. No.781/2026 and 782/2026 dated 25.06.2026 and that the petitioners are ready and willing to furnish sufficient sureties for their release on anticipatory bail and that therefore, the petitioners may be enlarged on anticipatory bail.



The Inspector of Police, Kulasekarapattinam appeared before this court and stated that the 1st and 2nd petitioners are the main accused and no previous case against these petitioners.

Considering the above facts and circumstances of the case and since the 1st and 2nd petitioner are the main accused in this case, this court is not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the 1st and 2nd petitioners and since there is no serious objection for the 3rd and 4th petitioners, this court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the 3rd and 4th petitioners subject to the following conditions:

i) In the event of arrest or on surrender, 3rd and 4th petitioners are ordered to be released on anticipatory bail on executing a bond for Rs.10,000/- each with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate, Tiruchendur,

ii) 3rd and 4th petitioners shall abide by the conditions stipulated u/s.482 (2) (i), (ii) and (iii) of BNSS,

iii) 3rd and 4th petitioners shall appear and sign before the the respondent police station daily at 10.00 A.M from the date of release for a period of 30 days,

iv) 3rd and 4th petitioners shall surrender before the Judicial Magistrate within 15 days from the date of this order, failing which, the anticipatory bail granted to the 3rd and 4th petitioners shall stand dismissed automatically,

v) If the 3rd and 4th petitioners breaches any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Judicial Magistrate is entitled to take appropriate action against the 3rd and 4th petitioners in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed by the said officer as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji .vs. State of Kerala (2005 AIRSCW 5560),



vi) And if the 3rd and 4th petitioners, thereafter abscond, a fresh F.I.R may be registered against the 3rd and 4th petitioners u/s.269 of BNS.

Vii) as far as the 1st and 2nd petitioners are concerned, this petition is dismissed.
