This Petition has come up for final hearing before this court today, in the presence of Thiru.A.Raj, Advocate for the petitioner and the Inspector of Police, Pudukottai police station for the Respondent.

Heard both side.

ORDER

Petitioners were granted anticipatory bail by this Court as per the order in Cr.M.P. No.2796/2026 dated 10.06.2026 with one of the conditions that the petitioners shall appear and sign before the respondent police station daily at 10.00 A.M., until further orders.

The learned Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that, petitioners have been complying the condition regularly from 19.06.2026 with great hardship and the petitioners are senior citizens about sixty years old and taking treatment for old age issues and A1 having hypertension and dyslipidemia and A2 is a Heart patient both were taking medicine and observing in A.V.M Hospital, Thoothukudi and the doctors have advised the petitioners not to travel any where and so it is very difficult for the petitioners to observe the above condition and therefore, the said condition imposed upon the petitioners may be relaxed totally.

The Inspector of Police, Pudukottai police station has appeared before this court and stated the petitioner has been observing the condition from 19.06.2026 for the past 21 days.



Considering the nature and gravity of the offence and the fact that, even though this court has imposed to observe the condition until further orders from the date of release, the petitioner has observed the condition for only 21 days and it is the duty of the petitioner to observe the condition in Cr.M.P. No.2796/2026 dated 10.06.2026, this court is not inclined to relax the condition imposed in the said order.

In the result, this petition is hereby dismissed.
