Petition u/s.483 BNSS is filed to grant bail to the petitioner.

This Petition has come up for final hearing before this court today, in the presence of Thiru.G.Basker, Advocate for the petitioner and the Inspector of Police, Kulathur P.S. for respondent.

Heard both side.

ORDER

The petitioner is alleged to have committed offences on 27.06.2026 u/s.126(2), 296(b), 351(3) of BNS and Section 25(1)(a) of Arms Act. The petitioner was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 27.06.2026.

The case of the prosecution is that, the petitioner waylaid the de-facto complainant, abused with filthy language and also criminally intimidated with sword.



The learned Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that, the petitioner is an innocent and not at all committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution and the petitioner is in judicial custody from 27.06.2026 for the past 7 days and no previous case against this petitioner and that the petitioner is ready and willing to furnish sufficient sureties for his release on bail and that therefore, the petitioner may be enlarged on bail.

The Inspector of Police, Kulathur police station has appeared before this court and stated that, this petitioner is always creating problems in the public and therefore now case has been registered.

Considering the nature and gravity of the offence and strong objection raised by the respondent police stating that, this petitioner has been involving in criminal offences frequently and the fact that, since the occurrence happened only on 27.06.2026, major part of investigation might not have been completed and if the petitioner is enlarged on bail, there is every possibility of tampering the witnesses and hampering the investigation, this court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

In the result, this petition is hereby dismissed.
