This Petition has come up for final hearing before this court today, in the presence of Thiru.G.Basker, Advocate for the petitioner and the Inspector of Police, Masarpatti P.S. for respondent.

O R D E R

The petitioner is alleged to have committed offences on 20.06.2026 u/s.105, 125(a), 125(b), 288 of BNS and Section 9(B)(1)(a) of Explosives Act. The petitioner was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 23.06.2026.

The case of the prosecution is that, petitioner along with the co-accused have acted in a rash and negligent manner causing simple and grievous hurt and committed culpable homicide by explosion of fire crackers.

The learned Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that, petitioner is an innocent and not at all committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution and that petitioner is in judicial custody from 23.06.2026 for the past 11 days and that the accident was not happened due to human error and the petitioner was admitted in the Meenakshi Mission Hospital, Madurai for his illness and the 1st to 4th accused are partner and they have filed Anticipatory bail application before the Hon'ble High Court and in the meantime this petitioner was arrested and other three accused persons were released on anticipatory bail and all the documents pertaining to the statutory authorities for the company has been produced and the incident has not happened within the premises of the factory and also compensation amount has been paid to the fatal victim and that the petitioner is ready and willing to furnish sufficient sureties for his release on bail and that therefore, petitioners may be enlarged on bail.

The Inspector of Police, Masarpatti police station has appeared before this court and stated that, the petitioner is taking treatment in Meenakshi Mission hospital, Madurai and the investigation is not yet completed.



Considering the nature and gravity of the offence and the fact that, even though the petitioner is in judicial custody, he is taking treatment as inpatient at Meenakshi Mission Hospital, Madurai and since the investigation is in the earlier stage, this court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

In the result, this petition is hereby dismissed.
