Petition u/s.482 BNSS is filed to grant anticipatory bail to petitioners.

This Petition has come up for final hearing before this court today, in the presence of Thiru.C.Joel Prince, Advocate for petitioners and the Inspector of Police, Pasuvanthanai P.S. for respondent.

Heard both side.

ORDER

Petitioners are alleged to have committed offences on 23.06.2026 u/ss.296(b), 115(2), 133, 351(2) of BNS and 4 of TNPHW Act.

The case of the prosecution is that the petitioners abused the de-facto complainant with filthy language, assaulted and caused hurt and also threatened with dire consequences and thereby harassed the de-facto complainant.

The learned Counsel for the petitioners has submitted that, petitioners are innocents and not at all committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution and that this is a counter case in Crime No.205/2026 and that the petitioners are ready and willing to furnish sufficient sureties for their release on anticipatory bail and that therefore, the petitioners may be enlarged on anticipatory bail.

The Inspector of Police, Pasuvanthanai police station has appeared before this court and stated that no person sustained injury in the occurrence.

Considering the above facts and circumstances of the case and since there is no serious objection on the respondent side, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners subject to the following conditions:



i) In the event of arrest or on surrender, petitioners are ordered to be released on anticipatory bail on executing a bond for Rs.10,000/- each with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate, Ottapidaram,

ii) Petitioners shall abide by the conditions stipulated u/s.482 (2) (i), (ii) and (iii) of BNSS,

iii) Petitioners shall appear and sign before the the respondent police station daily at 10.00 A.M from the date of release for a period of 30 days,

iv) Petitioners shall surrender before the Judicial Magistrate within 15 days from the date of this order, failing which, the anticipatory bail granted to the petitioners shall stand dismissed automatically,

v) If the petitioners breaches any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Judicial Magistrate is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioners in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed by the said officer as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji .vs. State of Kerala (2005 AIRSCW 5560),

vi) And if the petitioners, thereafter abscond, a fresh F.I.R may be registered against the petitioners u/s.269 of BNS.
