Petition u/s.482 BNSS is filed to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

This Petition has come up for final hearing before this court today, in the presence of Thiru.A.Sathya, Advocate for the petitioner and the Inspector of Police, Thalamuthu Nagar P.S. for respondent.

Heard both side.

ORDER

The petitioner is alleged to have committed offences on 27.06.2026 u/s.296(b), 351(3) of BNS and Section 4 of TNPHW Act.

The case of the prosecution is that, the petitioner along with other accused abused the de-facto complainant with filthy language, criminally intimidated her and also harassed the de-facto complainant.



The learned Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is an innocent and not at all committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution and that the co-accused was already released by the trial court and that the petitioner is ready and willing to furnish sufficient sureties for his release on anticipatory bail and that therefore, the petitioner may be enlarged on anticipatory bail.

The Inspector of Police, Thalamuthu Nagar police station has appeared before this court and stated that, due to previous motive, the alleged occurrence has taken place and raised serious objection to allow this petition.

Considering the nature and gravity of the offence and the serious objections raised on the respondent side and the fact that, since the occurrence happened only on 27.06.2026, major part of investigation would not have been completed and if the petitioner is released on anticipatory bail, there is every possibility of tampering the witnesses and hampering the investigation, this court is not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

In the result, this petition is hereby dismissed.
