This Petition has come up for final hearing before this court today, in the presence of Thiru. J. Senthilvelkumar, Advocate for the petitioner and the Inspector of Police, Thalamuthu Nagar P.S. for respondent.

Heard both side.



ORDER

The petitioner is alleged to have committed offences on 16.06.2026 u/s.296(b), 351(3) of BNS and Section 4 of TNPPDL Act and Section 4 of TNPHW Act and Section 3 of IES Act. The petitioner was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 17.06.2026.

The case of the prosecution is that, the petitioner has abused the de-facto complainant with filthy language, criminally intimidated her and damaged his house door by setting fire with petrol bomb and thereby harassed the de-facto complainant.

The learned Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that, the petitioner is an innocent and not at all committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution and that the petitioner is in judicial custody from 17.06.2026 for the past 17 days and this petitioner is not present in the occurrence place and no previous case against this petitioner and that the petitioner is ready and willing to furnish sufficient sureties for his release on bail and that therefore, the petitioner may be enlarged on bail.

The Inspector of Police, Thalamuthu Nagar police station has appeared before this court and stated that, due to previous motive, this occurrence has happened and if he is released on bail, there is a threat to the de-facto complainant and all the accused persons are friends and strongly objected to allow this petition.

Considering the nature and gravity of the offence and the strongly objection raised on the respondent side and the fact that, since the occurrence happened only on 16.06.2026, major part of investigation might not have been completed and if the



petitioner is enlarged on bail, there is every possibility of tampering the witnesses and hampering the investigation, this court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

In the result, this petition is hereby dismissed.
