This petition coming on this day for reply before me in the presence of Tr.S.Shanmuga Sundara Raj, Advocate for the petitioner and the Additional Public Prosecutor for the respondent and hearing the submissions of both sides and on perusal of records, this court made the following :

ORDER

1. This is a bail petition filed by the petitioner/Accused under Section 483 of BNSS., for granting bail to him.

2. The petitioner has been falsely implicated by the respondent police for the offences u/s. 294(b), 302, 120(B), 506(2) IPC and the case is now pending before this Court in S.C. No. 234/2024.

3. The learned Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner/accused No.2 not appeared before this Court on 05.02.2026 and this Court issued NBW against him and he was arrested and remanded on 16.03.2026 and he is in judicial custody for the past 114 days. The learned Counsel for the petitioner/accused No.2 has further submitted that he is innocent and he has not committed any offence as alleged and due to the family dispute, this case has been falsely implicated against him . The learned Counsel for the petitioner has further submitted that the earlier applications filed by the the petitioner/accused No.2 were dismissed on 30.04.2026 in Cr.M.P.No.1911/2026 and on 11.06.2026 in Cr.M.P.No.2917/2026 and the petitioner/accused No.2 would not tamper the witnesses in this case and that therefore the petitioners/accused may be enlarged on bail.

4. The respondent has filed reply stating that if the bail granted to the petitioner/accused No.2, there will be chance to abscond again and will not appear before this Court, and there will be a chance to threaten the witnesses. The respondent has further stated that the petitioners/accused No.2 have been involved in the following cases. The list of cases are mentioned hereunder :

- 1) SAYALKUDI P.S. Cr.No.134/2025, u/s.332(a), 103(1)[BNS @61](#)(2), 49, 332(a), 103(1) BNS
- 2) THALAMUTHUNAGAR P.S. Cr.No.312/20, u/s.341, 294(b), 324, 506(ii) IPC
- 3) THALAMUTHUNAGAR P.S. Cr.No.284/19, u/s.294(B), 323, 506(ii) and TNPWH Act.,
- 4) THALAMUTHUNAGAR P.S. Cr.No.247/20, u/s.379 IPC.

5) CENTRAL P.S. Cr.No.70/2012, u/s.294(b), 307, 506(ii) IPC.
and hence the respondent has raised serious objection to grant bail.

5. On perusal of records it is found that the petitioners/accused No.2 have been arrested and remanded on 16.03.2026, and considering the facts and circumstances of the case, and the criminal antecedents of the petitioners/accused No.2 and for the reason that the objections raised by the respondent and there is no change of circumstances after the dismissal of the earlier bail petitions, this court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner/accused No.2 at this stage.

In the result, this petition is hereby dismissed.
