Petition u/s.483 BNSS is filed to grant bail to the petitioner.

This Petition has come up for final hearing before this court today, in the presence of Thiru.P.Mathankumar Advocate for the petitioner and the learned Public Prosecutor for prosecution.

Heard both side.

ORDER

The petitioner is alleged to have committed offences on 22.03.2026 u/s.296(b), 109(1), 351(3) of BNS Act. The petitioner was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 08.06.2026

The case of the prosecution is that, the petitioner along with other accused have abused the de-facto complainant with filthy language, attempted to murder with Aruval and also threatened with dire consequences.



The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that, the petitioner is an innocent and not at all committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution and that the petitioner is in judicial custody from 08.06.2026 for the past 43 days and this is the 2nd bail application and the 1st application was dismissed by this court in Cr.M.P. No.3301/2026 dated 06.07.2026 and that the petitioner is ready and willing to furnish sufficient sureties for his release on bail and that therefore, the petitioner may be enlarged on bail.

The learned Public Prosecutor has raised strong objection to grant bail to the petitioner stating that, totally two accused in this case and this petitioner is the 1st accused and having three previous cases out of which, one case is under section 302 IPC.

Considering the nature and gravity of the offence and the criminal antecedents of the petitioner and one of the previous case is under Section 302 IPC and though the earlier bail application was dismissed on 06.07.2026, since there is no change of circumstances, this court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

In the result, this petition is hereby dismissed.
