Petition u/s.483 BNSS is filed to grant bail to the petitioner.

This Petition has come up for final hearing before this court today, in the presence of Thiru.R.Muthuraj Advocate for the petitioner and the learned Public Prosecutor for prosecution.

Heard both side.

ORDER

The petitioner is alleged to have committed offences on 28.06.2026 u/s.303(2) of BNS and Section 21(1) of MMDR Act. The petitioner was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 28.06.2026.

The case of the prosecution is that, the petitioner along with the co-accused have illegally stolen ¼ unit of river sand.

The learned Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is an innocent and not at all committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution and that



the petitioner is in judicial custody from 28.06.2026 for the past 23 days and due to statistical purpose false case has been registered and that the co-accused A2 was already released on bail by this court in Cr.M.P. No.3412/2026 dated 04.07.2026 and this is the 2nd bail application and the earlier bail application was dismissed by this court in Cr.M.P. No.3412/2026 dated 04.07.2026 and that the petitioner is ready and willing to furnish sufficient sureties for his release on bail and that therefore, the petitioner may be enlarged on bail.

The learned Public Prosecutor has raised strong objection to release the petitioner on bail by stating that, totally two accused in this case and this petitioner is the 1st accused who is a HS rowdy and having 11 previous cases.

Considering the nature and gravity of the offence and the criminal antecedents of the petitioner and the fact that, if this petitioner is enlarged on bail, he will indulge in similar criminal offence, which would affect the society at large and though the earlier bail application was dismissed on 04.07.2026, since there is no change of circumstances, this court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

In the result, this petition is hereby dismissed.
