Petition u/s.482 BNSS is filed to relax the condition to petitioners.



This Petition has come up for final hearing before this court today, in the presence of Thiru.A.Raj, Advocate for petitioners and the learned Public Prosecutor for prosecution.

Heard both side.

ORDER

The petitioner was granted anticipatory bail by this Court as per the order in Cr.M.P. No.2792/2026 dated 16.06.2026 with one of the conditions that the petitioner shall appear and sign before the respondent police station daily at 10.00 A.M., until further orders.

The learned Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that, the petitioner has been complying the condition regularly from 19.06.2026 with great hardship and the petitioner is a coolie and he is the only bread winner of his family and due to the observance of the condition, the petitioner is unable to go to his work and so it is very difficult for the petitioner to observe the above condition and therefore, the said condition imposed upon the petitioner may be relaxed totally.

The learned Public Prosecutor has raised objection to relax the said condition imposed upon the petitioner by stating that, the 1st petitioner is having 5 previous cases and no previous case against the 2nd and 3rd petitioners.

Considering the criminal antecedents of the 1st petitioner, this court to inclined to modify the condition imposed upon the 1st petitioner and since the 2nd and 3rd petitioners are not having any previous case, this court is inclined to relax the condition imposed upon the 2nd and 3rd petitioners.

In the result, this petition is allowed and the said condition imposed upon 1st petitioner in Cr.M.P. No.2792/2026 dated 16.06.2026 is modified to the extent that, the



1st petitioner shall appear and sign before the respondent police station weekly once on every Monday at 10.00 A.M., for four weeks and all other conditions in the said Cr.M.P. remains unaltered. With regard to the 2nd and 3rd petitioners, conditions imposed upon the 2nd and 3rd petitioners that, the 2nd and 3rd petitioners shall appear and sign before the respondent police station daily at 10.00 A.M., until further orders is totally relaxed.
