The complainant namely Sankar Das files a withdrawal petition on the ground that he has received the entire cheque amount.

Ld. Advocate for the complainant submitted that the complainant is no more interested to proceed with the instant case

The complainant is examined on dock. He submitted that he has filed the withdrawal petition voluntarily. No one threatened or influenced him to withdraw the case. He is no more interested to continue with this case and prays for withdrawal of the case.

Perusing the withdrawal petition filed by the complainant and considering the submission of the complainant, this Court finds no embargo to allow the complainant to withdraw the instant case.

Hence, it is,

ORDERED,

That the instant case be and the same is dismissed for non-prosecution. The complainant is at liberty to withdraw this case at his own risk.
