This petition was taken on file on 08.04.2026 and came up for final hearing on 21.07.2026 in the presence of Learned Counsel Thiru.Govindasubramanian appearing for the Petitioners/Accused and Learned APP for the prosecution. Having hearing both sides and having stood over for consideration till this date, this court delivers the following:

ORDER

1. This Petition was filed by the petitioner/AccusedU/s. 228 BNSS to dispense with the personal appearance of the petitioner/respondent.

2. The petitioner/Accused would submit that the petitioner/Accused is a Heart-patient, and he is taking treatment at DHAYA health care in Coimbatore and petitioner/Accused have taken an EGG and he has been advised by the Doctor to take rest and to avoid long travel and petitioner/Accused is a diabetic patient, and he has taking treatment in VBS Medical and Maternity Centre at Coimbatore and to rest as

much as possible. The petitioner/Accused further undertakes to appear before this court whenever the court directs. Hence the petition to be allowed.

3. Per contra, the Respondents/Petitioners in their counter stated that this petition is not maintainable at this stage. If the petitioner is exempted from his it will affect the trial. The petitioner/respondent has filed this petition to drag on the case. Hence the petition to be dismissed.

4. Heard and records perused.

5. The point for consideration:

Whether the petition filed by the petitioner/respondent is to be allowed or not?

6. On perusal of case records it reveals that this case, C.C. 766/25 was splitup against the accused and taken on file against him on 06.10.2025. This petition has been filed by the petitioner/ Accused to exempt his personal appearance during the trial due to his ill health. This petition has been filed by the petitioner/ Accused at the stage of appearance.

7. Hence, on considering the facts and circumstances of the case, and ill health of the petitioner/ Accused the personal appearance of the petitioner/ Accused is dispensed with on due representation of his counsel for every hearing and the petitioner/Accused have to appear before this court whenever he is specifically directed to appear before this court.

Hence this petition is allowed accordingly.
