Today is fixed for interim hearing.

OP files assets and liabilities. Let it be kept with the record.

Heard both the sides at length.

Perused the petition for interim maintenance, written objection and assets and liabilities filed by both the parties.

On perusing those, it appears to me that there are several allegations levelled in the petition against the opposite party and there are several counter-allegations levelled in the written objection against the petitioner. Allegations levelled by both the parties will be adjudicated after conclusion of trial. At this stage, it is difficult to adjudicate as to who was right and who was wrong in the matrimonial dispute. The object of Section 125, Cr.P.C. is very clear and that is to prevent starvation and to prevent vagrancy of a destitute lady. As First Aid, At this stage, I direct the opposite party to pay an amount of Rs. 2,500/- per month to the petitioner for her monthly maintenance. I also direct the opposite party to pay an amount of Rs. 2,000/- per month for the maintenance of her minor son. I further direct the opposite party to pay Rs. 4,500/- in total to the petitioner per month for her maintenance and for her minor son's maintenance. The opposite party is further directed to pay the ordered amount on 5th day of each succeeding British Calendar Month, failing which, petitioner is at liberty to execute the ordered amount in accordance with law. Thus, the ad interim petition is disposed of. This order will take effect from the date of filing of this case and as such I also direct the opposite party to pay the arrear amount to the petitioner in three equal installments starting from 3rd day of October, 2023.

Thus, interim petition filed by the petitioner is disposed of on contest without cost.

Let a copy of this order be supplied to the petitioner free of cost.
