Bail application filed u/s 480 of BNSS for an alleged offence punishable under section 303(2) of BNS.

This petition is coming on this day for hearing, Thiru. Muthu Lingam appeared for the Petitioner and Asst. Public Prosecutor Selvi.Preethi Rani Gr.II for the Respondent after hearing both sides, having stood over the consideration this court delivered the

ORDER

Notice issued to the respondent and Asst. Public Prosecutor and reply of police received.

The learned counsel for the Petitioner submitted that the Petitioner is innocent. He has not committed such an offence. The petitioner is in Judicial custody from 18.05.2026. On behalf of the petitioner, a copy of the bail order was submitted, stating that the Honorable Principal District and Sessions Court of Tirunelveli (Hon'ble Vacation Sessions Judge) has granted bail for the offense under Section 311 BNS in Crime No. 517/2026 of the Munnirpallam Police Station. The petitioner is Law abiding citizen and also ready to furnish substantial sureties for his bail and prays to enlarge the petitioner on Bail.

The Prosecution side submitted that the investigation is yet to be completed. In such circumstances if the accused is released on bail he may tamper with the witnesses and abscond and it will be difficult to secure him and he may commit the same kind of offence. Further submitting that, the petitioner is already involved in Cr.No.517/2026, U/s 311 of BNS in Munneerpallam P.S. Hence the Prosecution strongly objected to release the petitioner on bail at this stage.

Heard both sides and carefully perused the case records. The date of alleged occurrence took place on 13.04.2026. The de-facto complainant filed a petition to the respondent P.S. on 27.04.2026. The petitioner was remanded on 18.05.2026 and the investigation is pending.

Considering the nature of the case and gravity of offence and the case is in the stage of preliminary investigation and the petitioner has a previous case, if he is released on bail there is more chance for tampering the witnesses and to abscond hence, this Court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner. Petition dismissed.
