Bail application filed u/s 480 of BNSS for alleged offences punishable under sections 296(b), 118(1), 351(3) of BNS.

This petition is coming on this day for hearing, Thiru.T.Punjab Sekar appearing for the Petitioner and Asst. Public Prosecutor Tmt.Preethi Rani Gr.II for the Respondent after hearing both sides, having stood over the consideration this court delivered the

ORDER

Notice issued to the respondent and Asst. Public Prosecutor and also reply received.

The learned counsel for the Petitioner submitted that the Petitioner is innocent. He has not committed such an offence. The petitioner is in Judicial custody from 13.07.2026. The petitioner is Law abiding citizen and also ready to furnish substantial sureties for his bail and pray to enlarge the petitioner on Bail.

The Prosecution side submitted that the investigation is yet to be completed. In such circumstances if the accused is released on bail he may tamper with the witnesses and abscond and it will be difficult to secure him and he may commit the

same kind of offence. Hence the Prosecution strongly objected to release the petitioner on bail at this stage.

Heard both sides and carefully perused the case records. The date of alleged occurrence took place on 12.07.2026. The de-facto complainant filed a petition to the respondent P.S on 12.07.2026. The petitioner was remanded on 13.07.2026 and the investigation is pending.

Considering the nature of the case, and the fact that the accused has been in custody since 13.07.2026 for the past 08 days and further considering the period of incarceration as well as the fact that the injured has been treated as out-patient and it is observed from the Remand Report that there are no previous cases pending against the Petitioner, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner, subject to following conditions:-

1. The petitioner/ accused is ordered to be released on bail on executing bond for sum of Rs.10,000/-with two sureties each like sum to the satisfaction of this court.
2. The petitioner / accused shall report before the respondent Police daily once at morning 10.00 a.m for the period of 15 days.
3. Further the petitioner/ accused shall not abscond or tamper the witnesses and shall co-operate the investigation whenever required by the respondent for interrogation.
4. The petitioner shall report before the Respondent P.S as and when he is directed to do so.
