Chand Babu VERSUS State of U.P.

ORDER

04.08.2026: On behalf of accused Chand Babu this application has been moved by Shri Akhatar Ahmad Khan, Deputy Chief Legal Aid Defence Counsel, with the assertion that Bail Application No.389 of 2026 of accused/applicant has been allowed by this court on 08.07.2026 and amount of bail bonds were fixed Rs. 50000/- but the accused is unable to fulfil the said condition as he is in jail. So, he be released on temporary bail for a specified period so that he may comply the said order.

I have perused the order dated 08.07.2026, passed in Bail Application No.389/2026, whereby accused/applicant has been granted bail and also perused the report of District Probation Officer dated 30.07.2026.

As per direction of Hon'ble Supreme Court issued on 31.01.2023 in SMWP (CRIMINAL) NO.4/2021 IN RE POLICY STRATEGY FOR GRANT OF BAIL- ***In case where the undertrial or convicts requests that he can furnish bail bond or sureties once released, then in an appropriate case, the Court may consider granting temporary bail for a specified period to the accused so that he can furnish bail bond or sureties.***

Keeping in view the above direction of the Hon'ble Supreme Court, accused/applicant Chand Babu be released on temporary bail, **for a period of 01 month**, on his furnishing a personal bond of Rs.50,000/-. Accused/applicant shall ensure furnishing of two sureties each of Rs.50,000/-, in concerned case, within 01 month from his release on temporary bail. If accused/applicant makes compliance of this order within said period, then he shall remain on regular bail, with reference to order dated 08.07.2026 passed in Bail Application No.389/2026, otherwise, this order shall stand automatically cancelled and he shall have to surrender after expiry of 01 month from his release on temporary bail.
