This bail application came before me on 29.05.2026 in the presence of Tr.C.Murugesan, Advocate for Petitioner and Learned Assistant public prosecutor, Grade.II appearing for the Respondent/Complainant, this court delivers the following,

ORDER

1. This bail petition has been filed by the petitioner under section 480 of BNSS to release the petitioner/accused on bail, who was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 27.05.2026 in Cr.No. 183/2026 for alleged under section 305, 331(4) BNS.

2. The respondent police has submitted reply that if the accused is enlarged on bail he may involve in the same kind of offence again and the accused abscond and tamper the witness and so heavily objected to grant bail to the accused.

3. Learned Assistant Public Prosecutor submitted the investigation of this case is pending and if this accused is enlarged on bail he may abscond and tamper with

witness and so strongly oppose to enlarge the accused on bail.

4. Heard both. Records perused. The same shows that the accused was remanded to Judicial custody in this case on 27.05.2026. Reply of the prosecution shows that investigation is pending. Considering the stage of the case and nature of offence and serious objection made on the side of prosecution, if the petitioner is enlarged on bail at this stage, there are possibilities of accused meddling with the investigation and tampering of evidences. Hence, considering the nature of the offence and stage, this court comes to the conclusion that it is not appropriate to enlarge the accused on bail at this stage. Accordingly, in the result, this petition is dismissed.
