This bail application came before me on 13.03.2026 in the presence of Mr.S.Madhu Advocate for Petitioner and Learned Assistant public prosecutor, Grade.II appearing for the Respondent/Complainant, this court delivers the following,

ORDER

1. This bail petition has been filed by the petitioner under section 480 of BNSS to release the petitioner/accused on bail, she was arrested and remanded to Judicial custody on 26.02.2026 in Cr.No.81/2026 for alleged offence u/s.318(4), 319(2), 336(2), 336(3), 49 of BNS

2. The respondent police has submitted reply that, the investigation of this case is pending, and remaining case property 2 gm Gold and sum of Rs.1,05,000/-money are yet to be recovered from accused. If this accused is enlarged on bail she may abscond and involved in the same kind of offence again and also she may tamper the witness. So strongly object to grant bail to the accused.

3. The Learned Assistant Public Prosecutor submitted reply that, the investigation of this case is pending, if this accused is enlarged on bail she will repeat the offence and the society at large will be affected. Hence, it is strongly opposed to enlarge the accused on bail.

4. Heard Both. Records perused. The same shows that this Petitioner/Accused was remanded to Judicial custody in this case on 26.02.2026. Strong objection was also made by respondent Police to grant bail. However, the case is in initial stage of the investigation as seen from the reply of the prosecution. The remaining case property 2 gm Gold and sum of Rs.1,05,000/- money are yet to be recovered from accused. So if this accused is released on bail at this juncture she may involve again in the same kind of offence and so considering the serious objection made on the part of the respondent police and facts of the case, this court not inclined to allow this petition at this juncture.
