The Petition has been taken on file on 23.03.2026 and came up for final hearing before me on this day in the presence of the Learned counsel Tr.Siranjivie M, B.Sc.,LL.B ., appearing for the Petitioner and the Learned APP.Gr.II appearing for the Respondent and after hearing both sides and on perusal of records and having stood over for my consideration till this day, this court delivered the following,

ORDER

1. This bail petition has been filed by the petitioners under section 480 of BNSS to release the petitioner/accused on bail, he was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 07.03.2026 in Cr. No. 40 of 2026 for alleged under section 137(i) (a),145(b) RLY Act, 118(1),132,296(b) of BNS

2. The Respondent police has submitted reply that, if the petitioners/accused released on bail he may involve in the similar kind of offence and investigation of this case is pending, he may intimidate the witnesses. Since the petitioner/accused belongs to the state of Orissa, there are possibilities to abscond and so strongly objected to grant bail to the accused. The injured /victim discharged from the hospital.

3. The Learned APP has submitted reply that, if the accused released on bail he may abscond and tamper the witness and he may not appear before this court properly. Since, investigation of this case is pending strongly opposed to enlarge the accused on bail.

4. Heard both sides. Records Perused. The same shows that this petitioners/accused were remanded to Judicial Custody on 07.03.2026 in crime no. 40 of 2026 for offence under section U/s. 137(i)(a),145(b) RLY Act, 118(1),132,296(b) of BNS and Petitioner / Accused have been under judicial custody for 20 days. Though the Respondent police and Learned APP objected in reply stating that, the investigation of this case is pending, but records shows that major part of the investigation is over and case property also recovered and same was produced before this court and numbered as C.P.No.17 of 2026, Dated: 11.03.2026. Moreover injured/victim discharged from the hospital. And the respondent police did not object that any other previous case pending against these petitioner/accused. It was argued by the learned counsel for the petitioner that it is a falsely foisted case and that the petitioners are innocent person and further undertook to provide sufficient sureties and to abide by any conditions of this court. Hence, considering the nature of the offences and period of incarceration undergone by the accused and change in circumstances in this case, in the interest of justice this court inclined to allowed this petition on following conditions,

- a) That the petitioner/accused shall execute bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- like sum with two sureties each.
- b) That the Petitioner/accused shall appear and sign before respondent police station daily by Morning 10.00 A.M for 30 days.
- c) That the Petitioner/accused shall cooperate for interrogation as and when required by the respondent police.
- d) That the Petitioner/accused shall not tamper with witness and abscond and shall not involve in similar kind of offence.
- e) On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law (P.K.Shaji Vs State vs Kerala (2005) A.I.R. SCW 5560) be taken
- f) If, the accused thereafter absconds, A fresh F.I.R. be registered u/s 269 of BNS.
