This is an application under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of bail moved on behalf of applicant/accused.

Reply to the bail application filed. Copy supplied.

Arguments heard.

It is stated by Ld. Counsel for applicant/accused that applicant/accused is innocent and falsely implicated in this case and in JC since 21.03.2023. Further argued that investigation of the case has already been completed and charge-sheet has been filed and no useful purpose shall be served by keeping the applicant/accused in JC and prayed that applicant/accused be granted bail.

Ld. Addl. P.P. for the State has opposed the bail application stating that the allegations against the applicant/accused are serious in nature and bail application be dismissed.

As per previous involvement report, accused is also involved in two other similar cases (1) FIR no. 29657/2020, P.S. Mukherjee Nagar, under section 379/411 IPC and (2) FIR no.

884/2021, P.S. Rajouri Garden, under section 380/454/411/34 IPC and there is every likelihood that if enlarged on bail, he may repeat the offence. Moreover instrument of the offence of house breaking has been recovered from the accused. Co-accused Shekh Moizul @ Mustafa is yet to be arrested.

Keeping in view the above said facts and the facts that the accused is also involved in the similar offence, I am not inclined to grant bail to the applicant/accused at this stage, hence the bail application stands dismissed.

Copy of the order be sent to accused through Jail Superintendent concerned. Copy of order be also given dasti to Ld. counsel for the accused.
