AWARD

1. Petitioner claimed at Rs. 35,00,000/- as compensation for the fatal/injury caused to him/her in the Motor Vehicle Accident. The parties have agreed for full and final Settlement for Rs. 15,18,000/- (Rupees fifteen lakhs and Eighteen Thousand only) Hence the award is passed in accordance with Sec 21 of Legal
