The petition filed on 20.02.2025 and originally taken on file of III Additional District & Sessions court, Tirupathur and then transferred to this court as per the proceedings of the Hon'ble District and Sessions Judge, Thirupathur in Dis. No.7545/2025 dated 15.12.2025 and taken on file of this court, the case came up for final hearing in the presence of **Thiru.S.Veeramani,B.A.,B.L.**, learned counsel for the petitioner. The 1st respondent are set exparte and **Tmt.K.Nirupama,B.A.,M.L.**, learned counsel for 2nd respondent, and after hearing both side arguments, on perusing case records, which stood before me for consideration till this day, this tribunal passed the following:-

ORDER

1. This petition was filed by the petitioner's under section 166 of the Motor Vehicles Act against the respondents due to accidental death of their son claiming compensation of Rs.50,00,000/- together with interest and cost from the date of accident.

2. The averments of the petition in brief :-

The 1st petitioner is the mother 2nd petitioner is the father of the deceased Ramesh. In the Legal Heir Certificate issued by the Tahsildar Natrampalli the deceased Ramesh's brothers Rajasekar and Ramki were added wrongly. As per

Hindu Succession Act, 1956 when the I class legal heirs father and mother are alive, the II class legal heirs the brothers of the deceased cannot be legal heirs of the deceased. The said Ramesh was aged only 29 years and he is a B.E Aeronautical and MBA graduate. The said Ramesh was running a Cricket Coach Centre in Kallukuttai Village, near Bharathidasan College, in Natrampalli and was earning more than Rs.30,000/- per month. The said deceased Ramesh was maintaining the petitioners and they were depending upon his income. The deceased was the only bread winner of the family. The deceased was hale and healthy and could have lived another 50 years and could have maintained the petitioners. Due to the death of the Ramesh the petitioners future is completely spoiled and they kept in dark.

On 18.12.2023 at about 7.00 P.M. after completion of cricket coaching, the said Ramesh was riding his Hero Splendor Plus vehicle bearing Reg No. TN 23 BP 3756 on the extreme left side of the Velakalnatham to Pudupettai Main Road, while he was proceeding near to Bharathi Nagar Bus Stop, the another two wheeler bearing Reg.No.TN 83 MC 6872 came from the opposite direction driven by its driver in a rash and negligent manner dashed against the Ramesh and caused accident. Due to the impact the above said Ramesh was sustained grievous injuries in his back side of the head and all over his body. He was taken into hospital but he was died on the way. The postmortem was conducted at Tirupathur GH and then the body of the deceased Ramesh was taken to his native place Kuttigoundanur Village for funeral by private Car. The petitioners have spent a sum of Rs.50,000/- for transport expenses and spent a sum of Rs.50,000/- for funeral expenses.

A case U/s 279, 337 & 304(A) of IPC is registered by the Kandili Police in Cr.No.527/2023 against the driver of the Two Wheeler bearing Reg.No.TN83 MC 6872 and the same is pending for investigation. Since the accident took place due to the rash and negligent driving of the above said Two Wheeler driver. 1st Respondent is the owner and 2nd respondent is the insurer of the above said Two Wheeler are jointly and severally liable to pay compensation to the petitioners.

3. The Counter of the 2nd respondent has follows:

The allegations made in the Petition are hereby denied except those that are specifically admitted hereunder and the Petitioners are put to strict proof of the same. The respondent denied the Place, date and time of accident injuries, expenses incurred towards funeral and transportation. The Relationship of the Petitioners to the deceased is denied. It is also denied that the Petitioners are the dependents of deceased Ramesh and they are entitled to any compensation. The allegations in column No. 23 of the Petition are denied. The Respondent denies the allegation that on 18-12-2023 at about 7.00 PM, the deceased Ramesh was riding his Hero Splendor Plus Motor cycle bearing Reg.No. TN 23 BP 3756, on the extreme left side of the Velakalnatham to Pudupettai Main Road, while he was proceeding near to Barathi Nagar Bus Stop, at that time the two wheeler bearing Reg.No. TN 83 MC 6872, came from opposite direction was driven by its driver in rash and negligent manner dashed against deceased Ramesh and due to the said impact the deceased sustained grievous injuries and died on the way to the Hospital and after Postmortem at G.H. Tirupattur, the body of the deceased was taken to his Native place for funeral. The Petitioners

are put to strict proof of the same. And also Respondent submitted that the said accident had caused due to the sole negligence of the deceased Ramesh. Without D.L. and without observing the 1st Respondent's vehicle, he suddenly came across the road and caused the accident. He did not wear hand gear at the time of accident. Hence the Petitioners cannot claim any compensation for the own negligence of deceased Ramesh. Without prejudice to the above said contentions the respondent submitted that the claim petition was filed beyond the period of limitation as provided under section 166 (3) of M.V Act . Hence the petition is not maintainable in law. The rider of the 1st Respondent's Motor Cycle one Sundaravel, S/o. Raja, not possessed D.L. at the time of accident. The 1st Respondent knowingly handed over the motor cycle to said Sundaravel and violated the Policy conditions. Hence the Respondent need not indemnify the 1st Respondent and the Petition as against this Respondent is liable to be dismissed.

4. On the side of the petitioners, the 2nd petitioner namely Thirupathi (Father of deceased) examined as PW1 and Ex.P1 to Ex.P13 were marked, the eyewitness namely Kumar examined as PW2, and no exhibits were marked. On the side of respondent, the respondent side no witness examined and no documents were marked.

5. Points for consideration:-

- i. Whether the accident happened due to the rash and negligent driving of the two wheeler bearing Reg.No.TN 83 MC 6872 belonged to the 1st respondent?

- ii. Whether the petitioners are entitled for compensation? If so, what will be the quantum? From whom?

6. POINT NO.1:

The petitioners case is that, on 18.12.2023 at about 7.00 P.M. after completion of cricket coaching, the said Ramesh was riding his Hero Splendor Plus vehicle bearing Reg No. TN 23 BP 3756 on the extreme left side of the Velakalnatham to Pudupettai Main Road, while he was proceeding near to Bharathi Nagar Bus Stop, the another two wheeler bearing Reg.No.TN 83 MC 6872 came from the opposite direction driven by its driver in a rash and negligent manner dashed against the Ramesh and caused accident. Due to the impact the above said accident, Ramesh was sustained grievous injuries in his back side of the head and all over his body. He was taken into hospital but he was died on the way. A case U/s 279, 337 & 304(A) of IPC is registered by the Kandili Police in Cr.No.527/2023 against the driver of the Two Wheeler bearing Reg.No.TN83 MC 6872 belongs to the 1st respondent. Since the accident occurred due to the negligence of the driver of the 1st respondent and hence the petitioners are entitled compensation.

The respondent side contended the the said accident had caused due to the sole negligence of the deceased Ramesh that he had drove vehicle Without holding driving license and not wearing the helmet and without observing the rules of the road and suddenly came across the road and dashed against the 1st respondent's vehicle and himself invited the accident. Since the accident took

place due to the own negligence of the deceased the Petitioners cannot claim compensation to the respondents .

The 1st Petitioner is the father of the deceased and examined as PW1. He deposed the same facts in his evidence as PW1 as narrated in the petition. He is not an eye witnesses and he came to know about the incident later. PW2 is the eye witness to the accident. The evidence of Pw2 clearly shows that while he was landed in the accidental spot along with his friends, the deceased proceeded in his Hero Splender plus Vehicle slowly in the extreme left side of the road and the two wheeler TVS Radeon came from the opposite direction and driven by its driver in a rash and negligent manner and dashed against deceased who fell down from the vehicle and sustained head injury in his backside.

He further deposed that he informed about the accident to his father (PW1) and the same also tallied with the contents of the FIR marked as Ex.P1. The said evidence of Pw2 not shattered during the course of cross examination. It has been suggested that the petitioner not wore helmet and the same categorically denied by the witness. The driving licence of the deceased not produced. The tribunal cannot assume that no production tends to negligence on the part of deceased. What required means the negligence to be proved through the witness with regard to the manner of accident. There is no inroads expressed the negligence of the deceased is also one of the cause for an accident.

It is clear from the evidence of Pw1 that the accident occurred due to the rash and negligence of the driver of the TVS Radeon vehicle belonged to the 1st respondent. The copy of the registration certificate stands in the name of

R1 marked as Ex.P4. It reveals from the Ex.P1 that the criminal case registered against the driver of the two wheeler namely Sundaravel. It is established that the said Ramesh died due to the the head injuries as contained in postmortem Certificate marked as Ex.P2. There is no oral evidence to show that the accident to establish the negligence of the deceased as stated on the side of 2nd respondent. Hence, the tribunal holds that the accident occurred as per the manner stated in the petition.

As discussed in detail, the tribunal holds that the petitioners established their case with sufficient oral as well as documentary evidence . Therefore, it is concluded that the accident occurred only due to the negligence of the driver of Two wheeler bearing Reg.No. TN 83 MC 6872 in which belonged to the 1st respondent and termed as offending vehicle. The point No.1 is answered accordingly.

7) Point No.2 (Entitlement) :-

The petitioners 1 -2 are the parents of the deceased. Photo copies of Aadhaar cards of the Petitioners, Legal Heriship Certificate etc., are all filed by the petitioners. Though it has been mentioned 4 persons in the legal heirship Certificate Ex.P7, the said Ramesh died as bachelor and his brother cannot be dependents. The 1 & 2 petitioners alone the dependents to the deceased. There is no dispute raised in this regard. The accident occurred due to the rash and negligence of driver of the Two Wheeler bearing Reg.No. TN 83 MC 6872 which belonged to the 1st respondent as decided in point No.1. Hence the petitioners are entitled to get compensation from the respondent. Thus the point no.2 is answered accordingly.

8) Point No.3 (Quantum):-

The quantum of compensation for the above claim petition is decided as per the guidelines given in the decision of the Honourable Supreme Court of India, reported in 2009(6) Supreme Court Cases at Page 121 Smt.Saralaverma and others /v/ Delhi Transport Corporation and another.

9) Multiplicand :-

It is stated in the petition that the deceased was running cricket coach centre in Kallukuttai Village , near by Bharathidasan College at Natramaplli and he earned more than Rs.30,000/- per month. But, there is no proof documents regarding avocation or income filed by the petitioners. In the FIR Itself stated that the petitioner was running the cricket Coach Centre. It revealed from the educational as well as Extra curricular Activities filed that the deceased apart from academic success involved in sports during the school days as well as the college days as marked as Ex.P13 series. With regard to the educational qualification is concern he did B.E Aeronautical Engineering and M.B.A in Nehru Institute of technology, Coimbatore. The certificate of Merit itself speaks that he tends to became a coach. There is no adverse remarks regarding his occupation expressed on the side of 2nd respondnet.

It si settled by hon'ble Apex court that running coaching center needs Skill, Capital and reputation. **So they upgrade it to Semi- Professional or Professional.** . The data shows the Junior/entry level coaches (1- 3 years)earning around Rs.3.9 lakh per year (Rs.30,000 – 40,000/- p.m) and the

experienced coach 1 -12 years ranging from 5 L – 6 L per year and also the Top level academy coaches offered higher pay packages. Even the coach appointed in the educational institution as PT teacher could have earn the salary ranging between 20,0000/- to Rs.30,000/- p.m. The age of deceased at the time of accident 28 as a growing stage to achieve in a particular field. Considering the fact that the cost of living prevailed at the time of accident , age and other factors this tribunal inclined to fix the Notional Income as **Rs.22,500/-** per month.

10) Future Prospects :-

Admittedly, the deceased is aged about 27 years at the time of accident. So as per the Sarala Varma case, the petitioner being a Private employed person, an addition of 40% of actual salary income of the deceased towards future prospects is to be considered, where the deceased is not possessing a permanent job and below the age of 40 years is considered. Hence, out of the total income of Rs.22,500/-, 40% future prospects of Rs.9000/- is added towards the monthly income and thus the total monthly income is **Rs.31,500/-**.

11) Deduction :-

It is apparent that the petitioner was a bachelor at the time of accident. In view of the Judgment in the case between United India Insurance Co.Ltd., Divisional Office, No.73-C, M.T.H. Road, Ambattur, Chennai 600 053 /v/ Mumtaj , 2014 (1) TN MAC 127, the petitioners 1 & 2 being legal heirs of the deceased, 1/2 deduction has to be done and out of the monthly income of

Rs.31,500/- 1/2th amount of **Rs.15,750/-** is deducted for personal and living expenses and after deduction the monthly income fixed as **Rs.15,750/-**

12) Multiplier :-

The deceased is said to be 28 years at the time of the death as per the petition. The Aadhar of deceased reveals that year of birth 1994. The marksheet reveals that the DOB : 03.06.1994. Hence, the actual age as per the document the tribunal fixed as 29 and as per Saralaverma Case, the proper multiplier is **17**. Thus the compensation is worked out as follows :-

13) Loss of Dependency :-

The annual contribution to the family when multiplied by such multiplier gives the 'Loss of Dependency' to the family. So by multiplying the annual contribution with the multiplier 17, the entitled loss of dependency to the family is arrived as i.e., **Rs.15,750/- x 12 x 17 = Rs.32,13,000/-**

14) Loss of estate, Loss of consortium and funeral expenses :

The Honorable Apex court in National Insurance Company limited /Vs/ Pranaysethi and others (2017) has held that under the conventional heads of Rs. 15,000/- for loss of estate and Rs.15,000/- for funeral expenses and Rs. 40,000/- for loss of consortium be awarded and the aforesaid amount to be enhanced at the rate of 10% every three years.

Being the accident happened in the year of 2023 and hence, the 1st, 2nd petitioners are awarded a total sum of Rs.52,000/- (52,000/- X 2 = Rs.1,04,000/-) each towards loss of filial consortium. The tribunal also inclined to award compensation towards Funeral expenses and loss of estate a sum of Rs.33,000/- and Transport expenses a sum of Rs.10,000/-.

15) This tribunal is empowered to award higher compensation than the claimed considering the facts and circumstances of the case. Thus the petitioners 1& 2 are entitled for a sum of **Rs.33,60,000/-** as compensation. Being the accident happened due to the rash and negligence of the driver of the 1st respondent as decided in point No.1. The policy of insurance of the

offending vehicle stands with the 2nd respondent insurance company revealed from Ex.P.3. The Policy was in force at the time of accident. The driving licence of the driver of 1st respondent namely Sundaravel marked as Ex.P5. There is no violation of policy of insurance expressed and hence the 2nd respondent is liable to indemnify the 1st respondent as per the terms and conditions of insurance. The 2nd respondent is directed to pay compensation to the petitioners and thus point is answered accordingly.

In the result, this petition is partly allowed with costs in the following terms:-

1. The petitioners 1 to 2 are awarded a compensation of **Rs.33,60,000/-** (there is no period of DFD shown on thorough perusal of records). with

interest at the rate of 7.5% from the date of the petition till the date of realization within 2 month from the date of order

2. The 2nd Respondent is directed to deposit the award amount within one month from the date of order by NEFT / RTGS mode directly into the account standing in the name of Special Subordinate Judge (MACT), Tirupattur at State Bank of India, Tirupattur Main Branch, Account No. 42888609189 under intimation to this Tribunal by way of sending pay advice slip.
3. From the above award amount apportioned equally in the following manner, that the 1st petitioner is entitled to a sum of out of which the Rs.16,80,000/- and the 2nd petitioner is entitled to Rs.16,80,000/- from the date of claim petition dated 20.02.2025 along with interest as stated supra.
4. The petitioners are directed to pay the balance court fee if any within 15 days, otherwise the petitioners are not entitled any interest for the default period.
5. That the eligible Advocate fee fixed in this case as **Rs.40,600/-**.
6. The 2nd respondent is directed to pay a sum of **Rs.73,782/-** being the cost of petitioners tabulated there in.

7. That there is no need to prepare or draft the decree for this Award and further all the parties are entitled to get free copies of the award as per the Section 168(2) of the Act and Rules 20(6) of the Rules, as per order passed by the Hon'ble High Court of Madras in M/s Cholamandalam MS General Insurance Co., Ltd., Vs. Ayyanar and others – Judgment dated 11.05.2020 in Tr.CMP Nos.264 to 281 of 2020.

Note: The Judgement clarifies that the direction of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of ICICI Lombard General Insurance Company Ltd Vs Ayiti navaneetha & Others that a petition should not be dismissed solely on the basis of delay in filing the petition has been followed.
