This cause referred to the Lok Adalat organized by Tiruppur District Legal Services Authority under Section 19 of the Legal Services Authorities Act, 1987 coming on before us for endeavor's at Settlement of dispute between the parties, being the subject matter of this cause, in the presence of the parties and their counsels, and after a full and frank discussion of all issues factual and legal arising from the cause, the parties having agreed before us that there shall be an award/order/decreed in terms of settlement hereto made and the parties and their counsels herein having, acceptance of the same signed this in our presence, it is decreed / ordered.

TERMS OF SETTLEMENT

"Both parties are present. On negotiation, both parties have agreed for a settlement of the dispute for a sum of Rs. 3,80,000/- (Rupees Three lacs and Eighty thousand Only)

As per direction of the Honorable Supreme Court of India in *Parminster Singh Vs. Honey Goyal and others*, 2025 INSC 361, the 2nd respondent is directed to transfer the settled amount of Rs. 3,80,000/- to the credit of the petitioner's Savings Bank Account Number 42888609189 IFSC Code SBIN0000934, maintained with the State Bank of India Tirupattur, directly through NEFT/RTGS mode, within a period of _____ from the date of award and required to intimate the fact of such deposit to the petitioner as well as the Exclusive Motor Accidents Claims Tribunal, Tiruppur / Special District Court to deal with MCOP cases, Tiruppur by way of presenting a memo.

If the amount is not deposited within a prescribed period as mentioned above, the respondent is agreed to pay interest 7.5% per annum on the award amount from the date of this award till the date of deposit. The dispute between the parties is settled accordingly. Therefore, the award is passed in accordance with the Section 21 of the Legal Services Authorities Act, 1987.

The Court fee paid shall be refunded to the parties in the manner prescribed under section 69A of the Tamil Nadu Court Fees and Suits Valuation Act, 1955.
