

State Bank of India VS Rajinder Singh and Another.

Today, case was fixed for filing correct address of the defendant No.2. As per the office report, correct address not filed. Perusal of the file reveals that since 02.12.2023 as many as numerous effective opportunities were given to Ld. Counsel for the plaintiff for filing the correct of defendant No.2. Adjourning the case for the same purpose would not serve the end of justice. Hence, the present suit against defendant No.2 is dismissed in default.

Replication to the written-statement of defendant No.1 not filed by plaintiff despite availing sufficient opportunity. Plaintiff is debarred for filing the same. Efforts were made for amicable settlement between the parties, which they are not ready. Therefore, from the pleadings of the parties, following issues are framed which are as under:-

1. Whether the plaintiff is entitled for recovery as mentioned in the head note of the plaint and as prayed for?OPP
2. Whether the suit of the plaintiff is not maintainable in the present form?OPD
3. Whether the plaintiff has got no locus-standi to file the present suit?OPD
4. Whether the suit of plaintiff is not within limitation period? OPD
5. Relief.

No other issues arises or pressed. Both the parties are directed to file PF, DM and list of witnesses within 7 days. Now to come up on **07.02.2025** for evidence the plaintiff, at own responsibility.
