This petition came up before this Court for hearing moved by Mr. M. Padmasuresh, Advocate for the petitioners/accused and Mr. D. Manivannan, Public Prosecutor for the State and upon perusing the petition and reply, this Court passes the following:-

ORDER

This petition has been filed by the petitioners under section 483 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita to grant bail with regard to the case in Crime Number 197/2026 of Thiruvarur Town Police Station for the offence petition mentioned as punishable under sections 4(1)(A), 4(1)(C) of TNP Amendment Act 2024.

2. According to the petitioners, they are remanded to judicial custody on 14.05.2026. They are innocent persons and has not committed any offence as described by the complainant or whatsoever. The defacto complainant had stated that the petitioners have been in possession of 180 m.l., Men's Club Brandy – 14 Bottles, 180 m.l., Old Cheif Brandy – 8 Bottles, 180 m.l., Diamond Rum – 1 Bottle, 180 m.l., Black Pearl Brandy – 9 Bottles and 650 m.l., Thunder Bold Beer – 4 Bottles. The above case is a false one and it is foisted against the petitioners for the purpose of statistics. The respondent police had registered the case without following legal

procedures as according to section 32 of Tamil Nadu Prohibition Act. An earlier bail application in Criminal Miscellaneous Petition Number 379/2026 was dismissed by the Judicial Magistrate, Thiruvarur dated 19.05.2026. The investigation could have been completed at this stage and hence seeks to grant bail to the petitioners.

3. Whereas the Public Prosecutor has submitted the reply of Respondent / Complainant in which stated that the investigation still pending for want of chemical report and accused are secured and one accused is yet to be secured. If the petitioners have been released on bail, they will tamper witnesses, they will involve in similar offence and hence strongly objected to let the accused on bail.

4. Reply received and perused. Heard. The petitioners are custody from 14.05.2026 onwards. Considering the nature and gravity of offence and also other facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioners.

5. In the result, this petition is allowed with the following conditions:

- (i) The petitioners each shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.15,000/- with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the Judicial Magistrate, Thiruvarur.
- (ii) The petitioners and the sureties each shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar Card or Bank Pass Book to ensure their identity.
- (iii) The petitioners shall report before the Inspector of Police, Thiruvarur Town Police Station daily at 10.30 a.m., for a period of one month from the date of release.
- (iv) The petitioners shall not tamper with evidence of witnesses either during investigation or trial.

- (v) The petitioners shall not abscond either during investigation or trial.
- (vi) On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioners in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioners are released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme court in P.K. Shaji .Vs. State of Kerala ((2005) AIR SCW 5560)
- (vii) If the petitioners/accused thereafter abscond, a fresh FIR can be registered under section 269 BNS.
