This petition came up before this Court for hearing moved by Mr. M. PadmaSuresh, Advocate for the petitioner/accused and Mr. D. Manivannan, Public Prosecutor for the State and upon perusing the petition and reply, this Court passes the following:-

ORDER

This petition has been filed by the petitioner under section 483 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita to grant bail with regard to the case in Crime Number 113/2026 of PEW Thiruthuraipoondi Police Station for the offence petition mentioned as punishable under sections 4(1-A)(ii), 4(1)(A) of TNP Amendment Act 2024.

2. According to the petitioner, she is remanded to judicial custody on 17.05.2026. She is innocent person and has committed not any offence as described by the complainant or whatsoever. The defacto complainant had stated that the petitioner and others have been in possession of 180 ml., New Director's Club – 1404 Bottles. The above case is a false one and it is foisted against the petitioner for the purpose of statistics. The respondent police had registered the case without following legal procedures as according to section 32 of Tamil Nadu Prohibition Act. An earlier bail application in Criminal Miscellaneous Petition Number 180/2026 was dismissed by the Order of Judicial Magistrate, Thiruthuraipoondi dated

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19.05.2026. The investigation could have been completed at this stage and hence seeks to grant bail to the petitioner.

3. Whereas the Public Prosecutor has submitted the reply of Respondent / Complainant in which stated that the investigation still pending for want of chemical report and three accused are secured and other accused are yet to be secured and two previous cases in Cr. No. 229/2019 on the file of PEW Nagapattinam Police Station, Cr. No. 288/2018 on the file of Thittachery Police Station are pending against the petitioner. If the petitioner had been released on bail, she will tamper witnesses, she will involve in similar offence and hence strongly objected to let the accused on bail.

4. Reply received and perused. Heard. Considering the nature and gravity of offence, investigation is premature stage and strong objection of prosecution case and also other circumstance of the case, this Court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioners.

5. In the result, this petition is dismissed.
