This petition came up before this Court for hearing moved by Mr. P. Rajeshkumar, Advocate for the petitioners/accused and Mr. D. Manivannan, Public Prosecutor for the State and upon perusing the petition and reply, this Court passes the following:-

ORDER

This petition has been filed by the petitioners under section 483 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita to grant bail with regard to the case in Crime Number 113/2026 of PEW Thiruthuraipoondi Police Station for the offence petition mentioned as punishable under sections 4(1-A)(ii), 4(1)(A) of TNP Amendment Act 2024.

2. According to the petitioners, they are remanded to judicial custody on 17.05.2026. They are innocent persons and has not committed any offence as described by the complainant or whatsoever. The defacto complainant had stated that the petitioners have been in possession of 1404 bottles of 180ml NEW DIRECTOR'S CLUB Brandy bottles which was carried in TOYOTO ETIAS four wheeler bearing Registration UP 13 AV 0903. The above case is a false one and it is foisted against the petitioners for the purpose of statistics. The respondent police had registered the case without following legal procedures as according to section 32 of Tamil

Nadu Prohibition Act. An earlier bail application in Criminal Miscellaneous Petition Number 178/2026 was dismissed by Judicial Magistrate, Thiruthuraipoondi dated 19.05.2026. The investigation could have been completed at this stage and hence seeks to grant bail to the petitioners.

3. Whereas the Public Prosecutor has submitted the reply of Respondent / Complainant in which stated that the investigation still pending for want of chemical report and three accused are secured and two accused are yet to be secured and three previous cases of Cr.No.326/2023, Cr.No.587/2023, Cr.No.387/2019 are pending against the 1st petitioner and two cases of Cr.No.02/2025 and 587/2023 are pending against the 2nd petitioner and proposal to the Goondas Act. If the petitioners have been released on bail, they will tamper witnesses, they will involve in similar offence and hence strongly objected to let the accused on bail.

4. Reply received and perused. Heard. Considering that the five previous cases are pending against the petitioners and considering the proposal to Goondas Act and considering the pendency of investigation and strong objection of prosecution and the nature and gravity of offence and also other facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioners.

5. In the result, this petition is dismissed.
