This petition came up before this Court for hearing moved by Mr. P. R. Muthukrishnan, Advocate, for the petitioners/accused and Mr. D. Manivannan, Public Prosecutor for the State and upon perusing the petition and reply, this Court passes the following:-

ORDER

This petition has been filed by the petitioners under section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita to grant anticipatory bail with regard to the case in Crime Number 170/2026 of Koradachery Police station for the offence punishable under sections 296(b), 115(2), 118(1) and 351(3) of BNS.

2. According to the petitioners, they are innocent persons and the petitioners are from respectable family and have not committed any offence as described by the complainant or whatsoever. The case of the prosecution is that on 25.04.2026, the petitioners had filthily scolded, assaulted with kattai and caused injury and criminally intimidated the defacto complainant, his sister and wife. The petitioners are in no way related to the offence. The respondent police is giving unnecessary trouble to petitioner's family members. If they are arrested, they will be put to

irreparable loss and injury it may not be compensated by any means known to law. Since the petitioners apprehends arrest in the hands of respondent police and prayed to grant anticipatory bail to petitioners.

3. Whereas the Public Prosecutor has submitted the reply of Respondent / Complainant in which it is stated that the case is under investigation and accused are yet to be secured and the petitioners had assaulted the injured and the injured was discharged from the hospital. If the accused are let on bail, they will tamper witnesses, they will involve in similar offence and hence strongly objected to let the accused on bail.

4. Reply received and perused. Heard. Considering the injured has been discharged from the hospital, the nature and gravity of offence and also other circumstance of the case, this Court is inclined to grant Anticipatory Bail to the petitioners.

5. In the result, this petition is allowed with the following conditions :

- i. The petitioners each shall surrender and execute a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the District Munsif – cum - Judicial Magistrate, Needamangalam within one month from the date of Order.
- ii. The petitioner and the sureties each shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar Card or Bank Pass Book to ensure their identity.
- iii. The petitioner shall report before the Inspector of Police, Koradachery Police Station daily at 10.00 a.m., for a period of one month from the date of surrender.

- iv. The petitioner shall not tamper with evidence of witnesses either during investigation or trial and if otherwise the Anticipatory Bail granted in favour of petitioner shall stands canceled.
- v. The petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial.
- vi. On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner is released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K. Shaji .Vs. State of Kerala ((2005) AIR SCW 5560)
- vii. If the accused thereafter abscond, a fresh FIR can be registered under section 269 BNS.
