This petition for final hearing on 20.07.2026 upon hearing the arguments and upon perusal of the records and having stood over for consideration till this day, this court delivers the following.

ORDER

1. This is a petition filed by the petitioner's/ accused under section 480 BNSS for bail.
2. The learned counsel for petitioner's/accused has argued that, the petitioner's are arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 01.07.2026 and they have been on detention for the past 20 days. The petitioner's/accused have been falsely implicated in this case, the petitioner's are innocent and they are nowhere related to this case. Hence, there is no chance of tampering the witnesses and also they are ready to abide any condition imposed by this court and produce sufficient sureties for them bail.
3. The respondent police has given detailed objection stating that the trial is pending

and the petitioner's/accused are arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 01.07.2026. At this stage, if the petitioner's/accused are released on bail they are abscond and also tamper the witnesses. Hence, strongly objected to release the petitioner's on bail. The learned APP argued that, this case is pending before this court for trial and if they are released on bail, there is a chance of tampering evidences and witnesses. Hence, strongly objected to release the petitioner's/accused on bail.

4. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case this court is inclined to grant the bail to the petitioner's/accused on execution of bail bond for Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties each for like sum with the condition that

- i) The petitioner's/accused shall appear and sign before the respondent police station daily at 08.00 a.m without fail untill further order.
- ii) The petitioner's shall not abscond either during investigation or trial.
- iii) The petitioner's shall not tamper with the evidence or witness either during investigation or trial
- iv) The Petitioner's/accused is directed to cooperate with the interrogation whenever necessary.
