ORDER UNDER SECTION 446 of Cr.P.C.

1. The accused Raja @ Elanchezhiyan, who was released on bail on 01.12.2011 in the above case, and said Accused executed a bond for himself with 2 sureties 1. Nagaraj S/o. Vaithiyanathan 2. Rajendran S/o. Thambusamy for the sum of Rs.10,000/- each for the appearance of the Accused before this Court on every hearing date.

2. On 26.11.2021, when the case was called, the accused failed to appear, and no petition for exemption or sufficient cause for his absence was filed. Hence Non-bailable Warrant has been issued against him. It is informed by the Police that despite steps had been taken to execute the Non-bailable warrant against the accused, unable to comply with it, because he is hiding himself.

3. Therefore, a notice under Section 446 of Cr.P.C. was issued to his sureties to show cause why the bond should not be forfeited.

4. The sureties are appeared before the Court Today and filed a statement. The Court has considered the explanation submitted by the sureties. The explanation offered is found to be not satisfactory.

5. The Court is satisfied that the accused has committed a breach of the bond condition. Accordingly, the bond executed by the accused and his sureties are hereby forfeited to the Government under Section 446 of Cr.P.C.

6. The sureties are directed to pay the bond amount of ₹10,000/- each within a week days from today, failing which the same shall be recovered as per law under Section 421 Cr.P.C.
