Prosecution side heard. Records perused. On the basis of the available records, this Court passes the following

ORDER

1. The present application is filed by the complainant under Section 82(1) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, praying that this Hon'ble Court may be pleased to direct the accused to appear before this Court on a specified date.

2. Brief of the Petition

Originally, the Respondent police filed charge sheet before the First Additional District and Sessions (PCR) Court, Thanjavur. Against A1 to A7

that the case was taken on file by the First Additional District and Sessions (PCR) Court, Thanjavur as S.S.C. No. 16/2019. Thereafter, SSC No. 19/2022. As the accused did not appear before this Court warrant was issued and the same was pending. Hence, the case against this A3 Thilagaraj was Split up from S.S.C. No. 16/2019 and new case No. SSC No. 19/2022 was assigned for this A3. During pendency of the above case and due to the constitution of the Special Court for Trial of Cases under SC/ST (PoA) Act, Thiruvarur on 19.07.2025. This case was transferred this Court. This court issued fresh NBW against A3 on 20.08.2025. Despite steps taken by the police, the warrant could not be executed, as the accused has wilfully absconded and is concealing himself. Hence, the complainant filed a requisition seeking initiation of action against the sureties of the accused. Though the sureties appeared before this Court, they expressed their inability to produce the accused. Upon considering the representations made by the sureties, this Court cancelled the bail bond for breach of its conditions and imposed a penalty. The sureties have also paid the penalty amount. However, the warrant issued against the accused could not be executed and has been returned unexecuted with an endorsement stating that the accused is absconding and concealing himself to evade execution of the warrant. Therefore, it is prayed that this Court may be pleased to direct the accused to appear before this Court within one month and pass such other orders as deemed fit and proper.

3. Upon perusal of the records and materials available, it is seen that a Non-Bailable Warrant is pending against the above-named accused. Action has already been taken against the sureties who stood for the accused. Despite such action, the accused has not appeared before this Court. Considering the above facts, this Court is satisfied that the accused is concealing himself and that the warrant issued against him cannot be

executed. Therefore, this Court is constrained to issue a Proclamation under Section 82(1) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, requiring the accused, Thilagaraj, to appear before this Court on or before 23.03.2026 at 10.30 a.m.

The proclamation shall be published in the manner prescribed under law by:

- (1) Publicly reading the proclamation in a conspicuous place of the town or village in which the accused ordinarily resides;
- (2) Affixing a copy of the proclamation to a conspicuous part of the house in which the accused ordinarily resides or to some conspicuous place of such town or village; and
- (3) Affixing a copy of the proclamation to a conspicuous part of this Court. After compliance Call on 23.03.2026
