This case referred to the Lok Adalat organized by the District Legal Services Authority, Vellore, Under Section 19 of the Legal Services Authorities Act, 1987 (Act 39 of 1987) coming on before us for endeavors for settlement of dispute between parties being the subject matter of this case, in the presence of the parties and their counsel, and after a full and frank discussion of all issues factual and legal arising from the case, the parties having agreed before us that there shall be award/order/decree in terms of settlement hereto made and their Counsel herein having, in acceptance of the same, signed this in our presence, this Adalat doth order and decree:

AWARD

1. Petitioner/s Claimed at Rs. 75,00,000/- for the cause of Death/injury. The parties have agreed for full and final Settlement for Rs. 18,00,000/- /- (Rupees Eighteen Lakh Only/-). 2nd Respondent shall deposit the Award amount into the Courts' of Principal District Judge S.B.A/C No.42794170703 / 1st Additional District Judge S.B.A/C No.42830452508 / Sessions Judge Magalir Neethimandram (FTMC) S.B.A/C No.4288649607-4 / Additional District Judge (FTC) S.B.A/C No.42830499807 / Chief Judicial Magistrate Court S.B.A/C No.42805925850 / Sub Court, Vellore S.B.A/C No.42819684885 at State Bank of India, Sathuvachari, IFSC Code No.SBIN0008688 within 60 days from the of this order.

2. The Award amount is apportioned to the petitioners as follows:

- 1st petitioner is entitled to Rs. 1,00,000/- (Rupees one Lakh only)
2nd Petitioner is entitled to Rs. 14,00,000/- (Rupees Fourteen Lakhs only)
3rd petitioner is entitled to Rs. 1,00,000/- (Rupees one Lakh only)
4th petitioner is entitled to Rs. 1,00,000/- (Rupees one Lakh only)
5th petitioner is entitled to Rs. 1,00,000/- (Rupees one Lakh only)

3. Minor petitioner's award amount shall be deposited in any one of the Nationalized Bank till the minor attains Major.

4. In default of the Respondent No. 2 shall pay interest for the decree amount at the rate of 7.5 per annum from the date of settlement till the date of payment of the entire amount.

5. Both the parties to this settlement are entitled to file separate applications before the court where the claim petition is now pending for the follow up action if any, as and when necessary arises.

6. The Court fee paid if any shall be returned to the claimant as per the Rules.
