This petition is coming before me for hearing today in the presence of Thiru B. Rajaguru, learned counsel for the petitioner, the learned Public Prosecutor for the respondent and, considering that there is no representation on the side of the petitioner, this court, delivered the following:

O R D E R

This is a petition for bail u/s 483 of BNSS for the alleged offences u/s. 465, 466, 468, 471, 420 of IPC.

2. The petition averments is that the petitioner was remanded to judicial custody on 20.02.2026 and he is in custody for the past 18 days and the case was registered against the petitioner based on the false complaint given by the defacto complainant. The petitioner is innocent and no way connected with the offences and that the petitioner is having permanent residence and he is ready to furnish sufficient sureties to ensure his regular attendance and abide by any condition imposed by this Court, and prays that the petitioner may be granted bail.

3. On notice, the learned Public Prosecutor filed his objection and submitted that the petitioner/accused secured Government employment in the Postal Department by producing a forged SSLC mark sheet, relevant documents yet to be collected from the concerned department and the investigation is still in progress and strongly opposed to release the accused on bail.

4. No representation on behalf of the petitioner. Heard the Learned Public Prosecutor, who strongly opposed to grant bail to the petitioner. On perusal of objection it reveals that the petitioner/accused secured Government employment in the Postal Department by producing a forged SSLC mark sheet and the investigation is at the initial stage. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, nature of offence committed by the petitioner/accused, no representation on the side of petitioner and the investigation is still in progress, this court is not inclined to entertain this petition.

5. In the result, this petition is dismissed.
