ORDER OF SENTENCE;

1. Heard on question of quantum of sentence. Convict Tejwant Singh @ Fauji through his counsel Sh. J.S. Bhogal, Advocate stated that he is old aged and is the only bread winner of his family. He further stated that he is a poor person and has family to look after. Convict has requested for taking lenient view while sentencing him and stated that no other criminal case is pending against him and false case was planted upon him.

2. The convict was found in possession of 26 kgs 500 grams of Poppy Husk. No lenient view can be taken while sentencing the accused.

Accordingly the convict is sentenced as under:-
