e-petition filed U/S. 389(1) of Cr.P.C. to suspend the sentence passed by the **Judicial Magistrate No.II, Villupuram in C.C.No.116/2020, dated 18.12.2023.**

This petition is coming on this day before me for hearing in the presence of [Thiru.K.R.Senthilkumar](#) Advocate for the Petitioner and Thiru.T.S.Subramanian Public Prosecutor for the state, and upon perusing both side contentions, this court delivered the following:

ORDER

The petitioner/accused filed this **e-petition** u/s.389(1) Cr.P.C praying to suspend the sentence passed against the petitioner till the disposal of the appeal. The petitioner has stated in his petition that the petitioner was convicted for the offences under section 279 of IPC and sentenced to undergo S.I for six months and also convicted for the offences u/s.304(A) of IPC (2 count) and sentenced to under go S.I. for one year for each count as per the judgment passed by the learned Judicial Magistrate No.II, Villupuram in C.C.No.116/2020 dated 18.12.2023. Further the learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that now he has preferred appeal before this court and hence the petitioner prayed to suspend the sentence imposed till the disposal of the appeal.

Notice was issued to the Public prosecutor. But endorsed as “ No counter.

Heard. Perused records. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, and also the fact that the right of appeal is available with the petitioner, the sentence alone will be suspended, on his executing a bond for Rs.10,000/- with two sureties for a like sum each to the satisfaction of the Judicial Magistrate No.II, Villupuram. The petitioner shall appear before this court on 08.02.2024 without fail.
