e-petition filed U/S. 430(1) of BNNS, to suspend the sentence passed by the **Judicial Magistrate, Thiruvannainallur in C.C.No.141/2024, dated 06.02.2026.**

This petition is coming on this day before me for hearing in the presence of Thiru.N.Manivannan, Advocate for the Petitioners and Thiru.T.S.Subramanian, Public Prosecutor for the state, and upon perusing both side contentions, this court delivered the following:

ORDER

This **e-petition** has been filed by the petitioners u/s.430(1) of BNSS. The petitioners have stated in their e-petition that the 1, 3, 4 petitioners (A1, A3, A4) were convicted for the alleged offence u/s 324 of IPC and sentenced to undergo S.I for one year each and to pay a fine of Rs.10,000/- each, and in default to undergo S.I. for three month and 2nd petitioner (A2) was convicted for the alleged offence u/s 294(b) of IPC and to pay a fine of Rs.2,000/- and in default to undergo S.I. for 7 days and also convicted for the alleged offence u/s 326 of IPC and sentenced to undergo R.I for three years and to pay a fine of Rs.10,000/-, and in default to undergo S.I. for one year as per the Judgment passed by the Judicial Magistrate, Thiruvannainallur in C.C.No.141/2024 dated 06.02.2026. Total Fine amount of Rs.42,000/- was paid. Further the learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that now they have preferred appeal before this court and hence the petitioners prayed to suspend the sentence and release them on bail till the disposal of the appeal.

Notice issued to the learned Public Prosecutor. But endorsed as "No objection".

Heard. Perused records. Total Fine amount of Rs.42,000/- was paid. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, and also the fact that the right of appeal is available to the petitioners, the sentence alone will be suspended, on their executing a bond for Rs.10,000/- each with two sureties for a like sum each to the satisfaction of the **Judicial Magistrate, Thiruvannainallur**. The petitioners shall appear before the **Additional District and Sessions Court, (FTC), Villupuram** on **18.03.2026** without fail.

Accordingly, this petition is allowed.
