**ORDER**

This petition is filed by the petitioner u/s. 483(1) (b) of B.N.S.S. for praying to relax the condition by stating that this court already granted bail in favour of the petitioner in CrI.M.P.No.454/2026 dated 02.02.2026 with a condition that the petitioner shall appear and sign before the Respondent Police Station daily at 10.00 A.M. until further orders. The learned counsel further stated that the petitioner has been regularly complying the condition imposed by this court and hence the condition may be ordered to be relaxed.

The Learned Public Prosecutor has stated that the petitioner is regularly complying the condition imposed by this court from 06.02.2026 onwards, and no previous case is pending as against the petitioner and further he has no objection to relax the condition. Considering the fact that the petitioner is complying with condition regularly and no bad antecedents of the petitioner, this court is inclined to relax the condition. Hence the condition is totally relaxed.

**Accordingly, this petition is allowed.**
