Petition filed U/s.483(1)(b) of BNSS to Relax the condition which was imposed by this court order in Crl.M.P.No.1727/2026 dated 20.05.2026.

This petition is coming on this day before me for hearing in the presence of Thiru.J.Bharathi Raja, Advocate for the Petitioner and Thiru.T.S.Subramanian, Public Prosecutor for the state, and upon perusing both side contentions, this court delivered the following ...

ORDER

This petition is filed by the petitioner u/s. 483(1) (b) of B.N.S.S. for praying to relax the condition by stating that this court already granted bail in favour of the petitioner in Crl.M.P.No.1727/2026 dated 20.05.2026 with a condition that the petitioner shall appear and sign before the Respondent Police Station twice a day at 10.00 A.M. and 5.00 P.M. until further orders. The learned counsel further stated that the petitioner has been regularly complying the condition imposed by this court, and the petitioner is a poor coolie and hence the condition may be ordered to be relaxed.

The Learned Public Prosecutor has represented that the petitioner is complying the condition imposed by this court from 23.05.2026 onwards. The learned Public Prosecutor further stated that in this case final report was filed and yet to be numbered, and the petitioner has got 30 previous cases in his credit.

Considered the submissions on both sides and perused the records. The petitioner has obeyed the condition imposed by this court for the past 30 days. It is stated that in this case, final

report has been filed, but P.R.C. number has not been furnished, and the petitioner has got 30 previous cases in his credit. Considering the same and the nature of the offence and bad antecedents of the petitioner, this court is inclined to modify the condition as follows:-

The condition is modified to the effect that the petitioner shall appear and sign before the **Judicial Magistrate No.II, Villupuram** on **alternative days at 10.00 A.M.** till the case has been taken on file and thereafter appear on summons.

Accordingly, this petition is allowed.
