This petition coming on this day for final hearing in the presence of Thiru.Y.Ajmal Ali, B.Sc., L.L.B., Learned Advocate for petitioner and Learned Assistant public Prosecutor for state, after perusal of records, this court made the following;

ORDER

1. This Petition filed u/s 480 BNSS seeking to release the Petitioner/Accused on bail. Notice given to Respondent Police and reply received. The petitioner is facing charge u/s 304(2) BNS in Crime. No. 30/2026 of Vellimedupettai Police station. The Petitioner/Accused was in Judicial custody from 26.03.2026 for the alleged offence. The Petitioner counsel argued that the petitioner is innocent. He is falsely implicated in this offence and the petitioner is ready to obey the any condition. Hence, prayed for bail.
2. The Prosecution strongly objected this petition and replied that the investigation is completed and final report filed. Offence committed by the accused is grave in nature. The Petitioner may tamper with witnesses and hamper the investigation. The Prosecution relies the Judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in '*State of Tamilnadu Vs S.A.Raja*' and prayed for dismissal.

3. Records perused. Heard and perused the materials placed before this Court.
4. Records perused. Heard both sides. Considering the period of incarceration, nature of the offence is snatching, both aggrieved and Petitioner/Accused is belong to same Village Karuvampakkam and there is more probable of tamper the witness, hence, enlarging the accused person on bail at this time would cause serious prejudice to the case of prosecution, this Court is not inclined to allow this petition

In the result, this petition is dismissed.
