**** First Regular Bail application under Section 483 of BNSS. ****

ORDER:

1. This order will dispose of bail application under Section 483 BNSS filed by applicant/accused Gagandeep Singh @ Garry in case FIR No.160, dated 08.11.2025, under Section 21, 29 of NDPS Act, 1985, PS, City Balachaur.

2. The present bail application has been filed on the ground that applicant/accused is innocent and has been falsely implicated in present case.. The applicant/accused is in custody since 08.11.2025. Challan has already been presented. Conclusion of trial may take long time and no useful purpose would be served by detaining the applicant/accused in custody. Accused will not leave country without prior permission of the court. Lastly, a prayer has been made to admit the applicant/accused on bail.

3. Whereas, on the other hand, learned Additional Public Prosecutor, appearing on behalf of State has opposed the bail application by submitting that heroin weighing 155 grams was recovered from the accused. Applicant/accused has kept this quantity in his possession without any permit or license. Prayer has been made to dismiss the bail application.

4. I have heard Ld. APP for the State as well as Ld. Counsel for the accused/applicant and have perused the record carefully.

5. As per prosecution version, recovery of 155 gram heroin was effected from the accused on 08.11.2025. The challan has already been presented. It is a case of non-commercial quantity. The conclusion of trial will take sufficient time. The applicant is in custody since 08.11.2025 and no useful purpose would be served by detaining him in custody. Moreover, his custody will be burden on the state exchequer. Being so, the applicant is entitled to concession of bail.

6. Resultantly, present regular bail application stands allowed. Applicant/accused namely **Gagandeep Singh @ Garry** is hereby ordered to be released on bail, on his furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/- and one surety in the like amount, subject to the satisfaction of learned Illaqa/Duty Magistrate subject to the following conditions:-

(I) That the applicant/accused shall appear in the Court on each and every date of hearing.

(ii) That the applicant/accused shall not leave the country without prior permission of the Court.

(iii) That the applicant/accused shall not threaten or induce any witness to dissuade him from disclosing the true facts,

(iv) That the applicant/accused shall not indulge in the case of similar nature.

However, none of the observations made herein before shall have any bearing on the merits of the case. The present bail application stands disposed of accordingly. Bail file be tagged with the challan.
