Perusal of the record shows that the awardee/petitioner is continuously absent, whereby from its such conduct, it seems that he has lost the interest in this case .Further this case being 20 years old has been fixed for priority disposal as per the direction of the Honb'le High Court . As such the instant L.A. Case is hereby being dismissed for default with the liberty to the awardee/petitioner to restore the same after and when he appears in this case.
